**NOTICE TO EMPLOYEES POSTED BY ORDER OF THE
U.S. DEPARTMENT of the INTERIOR
An Agency of the United States Government**

This Notice is posted pursuant to an Order by the United States Department of the Interior (DOI), dated August 30, 2023, which found that a violation of Title VII of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, as amended, 42 U.S.C. § 2000e *et seq.*, has occurred at the U.S. Department of the Interior, Bureau of Indian Affairs (BIA), Alaska Regional Office, in Anchorage, Alaska (Facility).

Federal law prohibits discrimination against any employee or applicant for employment because of the person's RACE, COLOR, RELIGION, SEX, NATIONAL ORIGIN, AGE, GENETIC INFORMATION, DISABILITY, or REPRISAL with respect to hiring, firing, promotion, compensation, or other terms, conditions, or privileges of employment.

The Facility supports and will comply with such federal law and will not take action against employees because they have exercised their rights under the law.

The Facility was found to have violated Title VII of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, on an undetermined date during the period of August 23, 2021-January 29, 2022, when the Agency subjected an employee to unlawful per se reprisal discrimination.

The Facility has been ORDERED to pay compensatory damages, attorney's fees and costs, consider disciplinary actions against the responsible management official, require the manager and responsible for the discrimination take anti-discrimination training, and post this Notice.

The Facility shall not in any manner restrain, interfere, coerce, or retaliate against any individual who exercises their right to oppose practices made unlawful by, or who participates in proceedings pursuant to, federal equal employment opportunity law.
