MAYTUBBY REAPPOINTED PRINCIPAL CHIEF OF OKLAHOMA CHICKASAWS

Secretary of the Interior Douglas McKay today announced the reappointment of Floyd E. Maytubby, Oklahoma City, Okla., as Principal Chief of the Chickasaw Indian Tribe for a two-year term beginning October 18.

Mr. Maytubby has occupied the position for the past 16 years. In his present four-year term, expiring at midnight, October 17, he has received a salary of \$3,000 a year from tribal funds and an expense allowance of not more than \$2,500 a year. Under the new appointment, however, he has agreed to carry out the duties of the office without salary as a public service to the tribal members.

He will receive an expense allowance of \$12 per day when on actual duty.
