Fort Peck Water Project Dedication Features Acting Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs Del Lavedure

The Fort Peck Dry Prairie Rural Water Supply Project was dedicated in August by Acting Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs Del Lavedure. The community water project for the Fort Peck Tribes is the second major Montana water project built by the Bureau of Reclamation and supported by OFMC Operations & Maintenance (O&M) funding. The first was the North Central Montana Regional Water System serving the Rocky Boy's Reservation, which began construction in 2006. OFMC will provide funding for O&M to the Fort Peck Tribes through a Pub. L. 93-638 contract with the tribes.
