More Students Means a New Cafeteria at Blackwater Community School in Arizona

Increasing enrollment at Blackwater Community School in Arizona has prompted the installation of two modular classrooms and another modular building to be used as a cafeteria.

The Bureau of Indian Education (BIE) requested the buildings to relieve expected overcrowding.

The BIE Space Analysis Report determined the school needed additional educational space, while a determination was also made that the old cafeteria was not sufficient to handle the larger enrollment.
