

## MI&R OPTIONS

### CURRENT APPROACH (as explained by OFMC)

#### OPTION A: NATIONAL APPROACH

- **2/3rds of money allocated to schools with FCI mid-fair to poor; 1/3<sup>rd</sup> to others with severe backlogs**
- Regional ELOs submit regional priorities to national review
- Diverse **national** committee (education, facility, geography) reviews and selects funded projects for the year

#### OPTION B: REGIONAL APPROACH

- **100%** funding regionally
- Regional distribution **based on square footage** of all schools' educational and dormitory space in that region based on FMIS
- Decisions made by **Regional Committee**. Made up of ELOs, regional facility managers, superintendents from schools, facility managers

#### OPTION C: REGIONAL-NATIONAL APPROACH

- **2/3rds** funding regionally. Regional distribution **based on square footage** of all schools' educational and dormitory space in that region based on FMIS
- **1/3<sup>rd</sup>** funded nationally
  - Regional Decisions made by **Regional Committee**
  - Made up of ELOs, regional facility managers, superintendents from schools, facility managers
  - Prioritized projects not funded by regional funds forwarded to OFMC
- **OFMC** takes regional priorities across country not funded by regional funds and funds greatest needs across all prioritized backlogs nationwide
