**ORDER**

Upon consideration of the Parties’ Joint Motion for Entry of Order (Dkt. # 10) regarding Plaintiff Osage Minerals Council’s Motion for Temporary Restraining Order and Preliminary Injunction (Dkt. # 8 as filed in No. 15-CV-371-GKF-PJC) and Plaintiff Osage Producers’ Association’s Motion for Preliminary Injunction (Dkt. # 3) regarding the implementation of the Final Rule issued May 11, 2015 (80 Fed. Reg. 26,994), and for good cause shown,

**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:**


1. Upon the Joint Motion and consent of the parties, and without prejudice to any party’s contentions on the merits, this Court hereby enjoins the effective date of the Final Rule until August 10, 2015 at 5:00 p.m. CDT;

2. The Court modifies in part its Minute Order (Dkt. # 7) and hereby strikes the hearing set July 8, 2015 and resets the hearing on Plaintiff Osage Minerals Council's Motion for Temporary Restraining Order (Dkt. # 8, *Osage Minerals Council v. Interior, et al.*, No. 15-CV-371-GKF-PJC) and Plaintiff Osage Producers' Association's Motion for Preliminary Injunction (Dkt. # 3, *Osage Producers' Association v. Jewell, et al.*, No. 15-CV-367-GKF-PJC) (collectively, "Plaintiffs' Motions") for August 10, 2015 at 9:30 a.m.;
3. Defendants' response to Plaintiffs' Motions shall be filed by July 31, 2015; and
4. Plaintiffs Osage Minerals Council's and Osage Producers' Association's replies shall be filed by August 7, 2015.

Nothing in this ORDER shall waive, release, modify, excuse, or alter the obligations of any party or lessee that are imposed by existing law, regulations, leases, and other agreements.

No costs or fees shall be imposed on any party in regard to the entry of this Order.
