² The total number of required inspections per year reflects the number of school campuses in the BIE school inventory. There are 169 elementary and secondary schools and 14 dormitories in the BIE school system. However several are co-located on the same campus resulting in the 179 required inspections. The BIE school system also includes two BIA-owned post-secondary institutions.
