*“Post-Secondary Programs. ... The Committee directs BIE to complete annual health and safety inspections of all BIE system facilities and to publish quarterly updates on the status of such inspections.”*

<sup>1</sup> The total number of required inspections per year reflects the number of school campuses in the BIE school inventory. There are 169 elementary and secondary schools and 14 dormitories in the BIE school system. However several are co-located on the same campus resulting in the 179 required inspections. The BIE school system also includes two BIA-owned post-secondary institutions.

In FY2018, the BIE began executing its approved reform and realignment and assumed responsibility for annual workplace inspections for schools from the Bureau of Indian Affairs.
