

**Bureau of Indian Affairs - 2019 Congressional Directive
Region Annual Workplace Inspection Performance Summary for Schools**

This report responds to the following language in the H. Rept. 115-765 - Department of the Interior, Environment, and Related Agencies, Appropriations Bill, 2019:

Executive Direction and Administrative Services.— The recommendation includes \$224,880,000 for Executive Direction and Administrative Services. The following programs are funded at the requested levels: Assistant Secretary Support; Executive Direction, (Central); Executive Direction (Regional); Administrative Services (Central); Administrative Services (Regional); and Rentals. Indian Affairs is directed to complete annual health and safety inspections of all BIE system facilities, and to publish quarterly updates on the status of such inspections.

¹ The total number of required inspections per year reflects the number of school campuses in the BIE school inventory. There are 169 elementary and secondary schools and 14 dormitories in the BIE school system. However several are co-located on the same campus resulting in the 179 required inspections. The BIE school system also includes two BIA-owned post-secondary institutions.
