 - Transfer of Office of Appraisal Services to PMB
 - Cost savings from recompete of TFAS contract
 - Addition of \$ for Navajo and Hopi Indian
 Relocation

Transitions

- Appraisals moved to the Office of Policy, Management and Budget
 - Appraisal and Valuation Services Office (AVSO) established
 - Secretarial Order to be signed shortly
- President's FY19 Budget Proposals
 - OST to AS-IA
 - Land Buy Back Program to OST
 - Office of Navajo and Hopi Indian Relocation (land management and transition planning functions) to OST



Strategic Planning

- Current plan expires 2018
- New plan will cover 2019-2023
- Currently underway; Final draft by September
- Soliciting staff input via survey and 1-on-1 interviews
