Dear Tribal Leader:

I am writing to inform you that as of April 26, 2021, if you wish to register your Tribe for an “nsn.gov” domain name (nsn meaning “native sovereign nation”), you should contact the U.S. Department of Homeland Security’s Cybersecurity and Infrastructure Security Agency (CISA) rather than the Bureau of Indian Affairs. There is no change to current nsn.gov registrants.

The CISA is now responsible for the “.gov” internet domain program under the DOTGOV Act of 2020. *See* Consolidated Appropriations Act of 2021 (P.L. 116-260), Division U (Homeland Security and Governmental Affairs Provisions), Title IX (DOTGOV Act of 2020), Section 907 (Transition).
