Dear Tribal Leader:

The Department is proposing a new regulation to establish procedures and criteria for groups to seek Federal acknowledgment as Tribes under the "Alaska IRA" (i.e., under the Alaska amendments<sup>1</sup> to the Indian Reorganization Act of 1934<sup>2</sup>). This proposed regulation would establish an acknowledgment process for entities in Alaska that were not recognized as bands or Tribes before 1936.
