Dear Tribal Leader:

The Secretary of the Interior established the Bureau of Indian Education (BIE) Standards, Assessments, and Accountability System Negotiated Rulemaking Committee (Committee) in July 2018 to provide the Secretary with recommendations on the development of regulations to define BIE's standards, assessments, and accountability system consistent with the Elementary and Secondary Education Act (ESEA) section 1111 (20 U.S.C. § 6311), as amended by the Every Student Succeeds Act. In addition, the Committee was also asked to provide recommendations that encourage the exercise of the authority of Tribal governing bodies or school boards to adopt their own standards, assessments, and accountability system through the use of waivers as described in ESEA section 8204(c).

In March 2019, the Committee reached consensus on major sections of the proposed rule. A summary report of the Committee's recommendations was transmitted to BIE in early April 2019 and is available on the BIE website for your review. The proposed rule is being published in the Federal Register, and is also available at the following website:
