Subject: Approved Deviation from the Buy Indian Act

Pursuant to 48 CFR Part 1480.401, Indian Affairs must use the negotiation authority of the Buy-Indian Act, 25 U.S.C. 47, to give preference to Indian Economic Enterprises (IEE) whenever the use of that authority is authorized and practicable.

Basis: The Contracting Officer determines, after a thorough market survey/research, that there is no reasonable expectation of obtaining offers that will be competitive in terms of market price, quality, and delivery from two or more reasonable IEEs or at least one such enterprise that does not exceed the dollar threshold in FAR 13.003. The Contracting Officer should not rely solely on the program for this determination.

Deviation is authorized *prior to* issuing the solicitation for other than simplified or commercial items.

Basis: The Contracting Officer determines, after a thorough research, that there is no reasonable expectation that offers will be received from two or more responsible IEEs at a reasonable and fair market price. The Contracting Officer should not rely solely on the program for this determination.
