AN ACTION

RELATING TO RESOURCES AND DEVELOPMENT; APPROVING THE INTEGRATED RESOURCE MANAGEMENT PLAN FOR THE FORMER BENNETT FREEZE AREA

BE IT ENACTED:

SECTION ONE. AUTHORITY

- A. Pursuant to 2 N.N.C. § 500 (C)(1), the Resources and Development Committee of the Navajo Nation Council has oversight authority over land, environment, environmental protection, cultural resources "[t]o establish Navajo Nation policy with respect to the optimum utilization of all Navajo Nation resources and to protect the rights, interests, sacred sites and freedoms of the Navajo Nation and People to such resources, now and for future generations."
- B. Pursuant to 2 N.N.C. § 500 (C)(2), the Resources and Development Committee of the Navajo Nation Council has the authority "[t]o oversee regulation of activities on Navajo Nation lands for disposition or acquisition of resources, surface disturbance, or alternation of the natural state of the resource, including the enforcement and administration of applicable Navajo Nation and federal laws, regulations, guidelines, and administrative procedures in the development and use of resources as a good steward."

SECTION TWO. FINDINGS

In 1934 the federal government added about 234,000 acres to Α. the Western Navajo Agency of the Navajo Nation. In 1966 the Commission of Indian Affairs, Robert Bennett, development on 1.6 million acres of Navajo Nation northeastern Arizona that was claimed by both the Navajo Nation and the Hopi Tribe. The ban became known as the In 2006 the ban was lifted. In 2015, Bennett Freeze Area. the Navajo Nation and the Bureau of Indian Affairs signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) "the purpose ... is for the developing an IRMP [Integrated Resource Management Plan] for the Former Bennett Freeze Area (FBFA) of the Navajo Nation. Furthermore, this MOU defines the resources to be evaluated, identifies interdisciplinary team members from both the BIA and Navajo Nation, defines roles and responsibilities of each

party and identifies the project time frames. It is the intent of the Navajo Nation and BIA to provide for a cooperative relationship to develop integrated resource management goals and polices that will provide direction for the planning and the implementation of the IRMP of the FBFA while protecting the environmental and cultural values." The Memorandum of Understanding between the Navajo Nation and the Bureau of Indian Affairs, Navajo Regional Office is attached as **Exhibit B**. The Former Bennett Freeze Area's Integrated Resource Management Plan Handout dated August 14, 2020 is attached as **Exhibit C**.

- B. The Former Bennett Freeze Area-Integrated Resource Management Plan was completed and is attached as **Exhibit A**.
- C. The Navajo-Hopi Land Commission "supports the initiative and process for fulfilling the FBFA-IRMA" as stated in Resolution NHLCS-10-2020 which attached as **Exhibit D**. Memorandum dated September 10, 2020 from the Navajo-Hopi Land Commission to the BIA Regional Director is attached as **Exhibit E**.
