Subject:	Describe nature of event/ alert
From:	Who is writing the alert, (include position)
What:	1 sentence that describes what is occurring
When:	Month, day, year and approximate local time of event
Who:	1-2 sentences that explains who was involved in nature of event
Where:	Name the location of event (include reservation and state)
Background:	2-4 sentences that provide context to event. If event is complete, use space to provi thorough documentation of event. If lesson learned can be given / shared, include it section (length not limited).
Initial Response:	Describe actions taken.
Planned Actions:	What is planned in the next 24 hours?
Email sent to:	Identify mailing lists and individual names Early Alert was sent to for notification
Date/Time Sent:	When notification was sent to BWFM National On-Call Duty Officer
