Subject: Pulaski Award Nominations

<u>Purpose</u>: To announce Pulaski Award nomination process is now open. This is an annual, national award for outstanding contributions to wildland firefighting from America's wildland firefighters. The Pulaski is a half-axe/half-hoe tool designed for wildland firefighting and named after a forest ranger who led a crew to safety during the Montana/Idaho inferno of 1910.

Timeframe: Nomination letters must be received by February 25, 2022.

<u>Policy/Action</u>: The National Interagency Fire Center fire directors issued the attached five-step criteria with instructions on how to submit a nomination for an individual, business, government, or non-profit entity.
