Subject: 2019 Direction to Wildland Fire Leadership

As we approach another wildfire season, I want to recognize the important role that our firefighters play in protecting the public, communities and natural resources. The coming months will be the busiest as preparedness levels reach their highest and firefighters and resources are deployed across the country. We look to you for the leadership and expertise that is needed to safely and effectively carry out the Department of the Interior's (DOI) core wildland fire management mission.

On the fire line, on the road, and back at home, the well-being and safety of our firefighters is our highest priority as we manage increasingly complex incidents and endure competing demands.
