 - Includes CatEx's, EA's and 5 active EIS's.
Phase I Environmental Site Assessments.
 - Phase I Cultural Resource Surveys.
 - Each NEPA action requires NHPA compliance.
 - Provide services for Roads, Fee to Trust, Realty, Fire, Forestry, Water Resources, GLRI and all 36 tribes.

Accomplishments

- In FY2016 completed compliance reviews for over 14,000 acres of fee to trust applications.
- Completed Final Environmental Impact Statement and Draft Record of Decision.
- Completed NEPA and NHPA reviews for +/- 7,000 acres.
- 650 NEPA documents completed to date for FY 16.
