- 23 Parcels Taken into Trust Status (1,779.45 acres)
- 19 Completed Cases (2,192.48 acres)
- 15 Notice of Decisions issued (201.68 acres)
- 10 Reservation Proclamations published (520.10 acres)



Challenges

The number of appeals, negative comments, or objections received from local governments and private citizens has greatly increased.

More than 50% of our active fee to trust applications have received an appeal, negative comment, or objection.

FY15? More than 70%



Responding to the Challenge

In FY16, 14 of the Division's cases were in appeal status:

- 12 Interior Board of Indian Appeals
- 2 Assistant Secretary–Indian Affairs

Interior Board of Indian Appeals upheld all 12 of the Regional Director's decisions. The Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs dismissed the two remaining appeals.

All appeals were successfully resolved.
