This vehicle is owned and operated by the United States Government and, as such, is exempt from state laws pertaining to liability insurance coverage under the Supremacy clause of the United States Constitution, Article 6, clause 2, and the specific provisions of each state's laws.

Government employees who use Government owned vehicles, commercially leased vehicles, or privately owned vehicles in performing official business within the geographic United States including Alaska and Hawaii, Puerto Rico, Guam, or the United States territories and possessions are covered by the Federal Government as a self insurer in the areas of loss or damage to the Government property and the liability of Government employees for actions within the scope of their duties.
