Safety Leave)

The Department of Interior's (DOI) Office of Human Capital Management, in conjunction with the Bureau of Land Management, National Park Service, U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service, and Bureau of Indian Affairs along with the Department of Agriculture's Forest Service, work collaboratively to support wildland fire management personnel and mitigate the safety risks of extreme fatigue. The DOI has aligned its rest and recuperation period to meet the new standard of mandatory three days' rest and recuperations immediately following such an assignment.

Attached is the memorandum to grant an exception to policy Section 12 of Personnel Bulletin (PB) 19-04, Weather and Safety Leave, until the PB can be updated.
