SALE OF LEASES: The opening of bids on tracts for oil and gas mining purposes will be conducted **Tuesday, August 25, 2026**, under regulatory provisions cited in 25 C.F.R. § 211, promulgating the Act of May 11, 1938 (52 Stat. 347), as to tribally-owned properties, 25 C.F.R. § 212 (act of March 3, 1909, 35 Stat. 783), and in 25 C.F.R. § 213, promulgating the Act of May 27, 1908 (35 Stat. 312), as to individually-owned properties. The Secretary of the Interior reserves the right to withdraw, add or correct a legal description or item, and reject any bid and to disapprove any lease submitted on an accepted bid when such is in the best interest of the Indians. Tribally-held properties are offered for lease subject to acceptance by the duly authorized governing body of the Tribal entity. Individually-owned properties are offered subject to acceptance by the individual mineral owner(s). Undivided non-Indian fee interests may be contained within the advertised tracts, and it is the responsibility of the successful bidder to secure a separate lease agreement with non-Indian interest owners.

SEALED BIDS: Bids will be accepted for consideration until **2 p.m., Tuesday, August 25, 2026**, and opened at that time in the Eastern Oklahoma Regional Office, Bureau of Indian Affairs, 3100 West Peak Boulevard, conference room, Muskogee, Oklahoma, for the leasing of the listed and described properties for oil and gas mining purposes. Each tract is offered separately. BIDS ARE TO BE SUBMITTED IN SEALED ENVELOPES, CLEARLY MARKED TO THE REGIONAL DIRECTOR, EASTERN OKLAHOMA REGIONAL OFFICE, P.O. Box 8002, MUSKOGEE, OKLAHOMA 74402-8002, and identified as "**BID FOR OIL AND GAS MINING LEASE,**" Not to be opened until **2 p.m., Tuesday, August 25, 2026, TRACT NO.** (Identified).

Each bid must be submitted on a standard bid form provided by the Bureau of Indian Affairs and accompanied by a deposit of at least 25 percent of the bonus offered along with the enclosed FBMS Customer Request form. Such deposit is to be made by cashier's check, certified check, or postal money order payable to the **Bureau of Indian Affairs**. Deposits received from unsuccessful bidders will be returned. In the event that two or more high bids on a tract are the same amount, sealed bids shall be required to be resubmitted. A Fair Market Value evaluation will be requested from the DOI Appraisal and Valuation Services Office, Division of Minerals Evaluation to verify that the bid meets or exceeds the appraised value, and the bidder will be notified.

Within 30 days of notification, each successful bidder must remit the balance of the bonus, first year's rental, calculated at the rate of \$3 per acre along with the advertising cost and filing fee of \$77.50 for each lease. Within this 30-day period, the lease, in completed form, shall be filed with the Regional Director, unless for good and sufficient reason, an extension for filing of the lease document has been granted. **NO EXTENSION**, however, may be granted for remitting the balance of monies due the mineral owner.

FORFEITURE OF DEPOSIT: Failure of the successful bidder to pay the full consideration within the specified period or failure to file the completed lease within said period of time or extension thereof, or if the lease is disapproved through no fault of the lessor or the Department

of the Interior, the deposited 25 percent of the bonus bid shall be forfeited for the use and benefit of the mineral owner, in accordance with regulations. Once tribally executed leases and resolutions have been submitted to the Bureau of Indian Affairs, no refund of bonus and rental paid for any tract will be refunded.

DECLINATION OF BID: In the event that any bid or offer is rejected, any and all monies deposited, except for that amount paid for advertising cost, will be returned to the bidder.

IMPORTANT NOTICE

LEASE FORM: Standard departmental lease forms provided by the Bureau of Indian Affairs are required to be used. For allotted, individually-held properties, each successful bidder will be required to obtain the signature of the Indian lessor. For tribally-held properties, the lease document will be completed and signatory acceptance obtained by the Department. Leases are not valid until approved by the Secretary.

LEASE PROVISIONS: Three-year primary term, \$3 per acre rental per annum, AND A 1/5THS RATE OF ROYALTY FOR ALL PROPERTIES EXCEPT A 1/4TH RATE OF ROYALTY FOR ALL MUSCOGEE (CREEK) NATION TRIBAL PROPERTIES. The primary term will be extended by the production of oil and/or gas in paying quantities. If drilling of a well is commenced within the primary term of the lease, the lessee shall have the right to drill such well to completion with reasonable diligence, and if oil and/or gas is found in paying quantities, the lease shall continue to be in force as if such well had been completed within the primary term. Annual rental is due and payable on each anniversary date of the lease, or as specified and provided under the terms of the lease.

BONDING REQUIREMENTS: Bonding is necessary, and Lessee shall furnish with each lease an appropriate surety bond in proper form, as specified by regulations. Acceptable forms will be made available by the Bureau of Indian Affairs. PRODUCING LEASES are subject to increases in the amount of required coverage.

SECRETARY APPROVAL OF INDIVIDUALLY OWNED LEASES. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the Secretary may approve any lease or agreement that affects individually owned allotted land or any other land held in trust or restricted status by the Secretary on behalf of an Indian based on the applicable percentages pursuant to Title 25, United States Code Annotated, Section 2218.

SPECIAL NOTICE

The lessee shall certify that development and operation of the lease shall be conducted in conformity with the National Environmental Policy Act of 1969. The lessee is responsible for complying with operational requirements imposed by regulations governing submission of all applications for development through the Bureau of Land Management Office.
