TRIBAL RESOLUTION NO. 05112026

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING SUBMISSION OF THE CRITERION 83.11 (E) SUPPLEMENT TO THE PETITION FOR FEDERAL ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF THE JUANEÑO BAND OF MISSION INDIANS ACJACHEMEN NATION

WHEREAS, the Juaneño Band of Mission Indians Acjachemen Nation has existed since time (the “Tribe”) immemorial within our ancestral homelands, maintaining an unbroken relationship with our lands, waters, sacred sites, and cultural resources; and

WHEREAS, the Juaneño Band of Mission Indians Acjachemen Nation Tribal Council (the “Council”) constitutes the governing body of the Tribe; and

WHEREAS, the Tribe has for decades now researched and prepared a fully documented petition for Federal Acknowledgment under 25 C.F.R. Part 83 that was initially submitted on August 17, 1982, and supplemented thereafter (the “Petition”) to the Assistant Secretary – Indian Affairs, U.S. Department of the Interior; and

WHEREAS, the Tribe through its Tribal Chairman, Tribal members and consultants conducted meetings on April 2, 2025, and February 26, 2026, with the Office of Federal Acknowledgment (the “OFA”) staff and Solicitor regarding supplementing criterion 83.11 (e) the Tribe’s Petition; and

WHEREAS, the Tribe and the Federal Recognition Committee has prepared a supplement to criterion 83.11 (e) of the Petition (the “Criterion 83.11(e) Supplement”), which includes the following:

1. Cover letter from Chairman Nathan K. Banda dated May 9, 2026;
2. This Resolution Authorizing Submission of the Criterion 83.11 (e) Supplement to the Petition for Federal Acknowledgment of the Juaneño Band of Mission Indians Acjachemen Nation,
3. Cover sheets to the Criterion 83.11 (e) Supplement to the Petition,
4. A digital copy of the Criterion 83.11 (e) Supplement to the Petition,
5. A hard copy of the Criterion 83.11 (e) Supplement to the Petition; and

WHEREAS, the Tribe has reconciled the digital copy of the Criterion 83.11 (e) Supplement to the Petition and the hard copy of the Criterion 83.11 (e) Supplement to the Petition, the digital copy and hard copy are verified as accurate and consistent; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has reviewed and approved the contents of the Criterion 83.11 (e) Supplement to the Petition.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

The Tribal Council hereby authorizes the submission of the Criterion 83.11 (e) Supplement to the AS-IA, which includes the following:

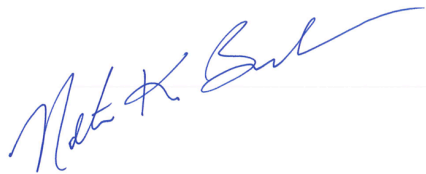
1. Cover letter from Chairman Nathan K. Banda dated May 9, 2026;

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BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption by the Tribal Council of the Juaneño Band of Mission Indians Acjachemen Nation at a duly called meeting with quorum present on this 9th day of May 2026.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, all resolutions or parts of resolutions, or other applicable Tribal law, inconsistent with this resolution are repealed. This resolution is effective immediately and shall continue pursuant to the sovereign authority vested in the Tribal Council.

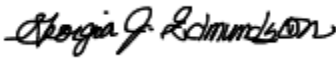
