Thank you for your letter dated February 27, 2014, requesting a 6 month extension to respond to the August 23, 2013, affirmative Secretarial Determination for the Menominee Indian Tribe to conduct gaming on land in Kenosha, Wisconsin.

The regulations at 25 C.F.R. § 292.23(b) provide that if the Governor does not affirmatively concur in the Secretarial Determination within 1 year of the date of the request, the Secretary may, at the request of the applicant tribe or the Governor, grant an extension of up to 180 days. Pursuant to the regulations, you are granted an extension of 180 days after the 1 year consideration period ends on August 23, 2014, to concur in the Secretary's affirmative 2-part determination.
