On behalf of the Yocha Dehe Wintun Nation, a federally recognized tribal government ("Yocha Dehe" or "Tribe"), and pursuant to the Freedom of Information Act ("FOIA"), 5 U.S.C. § 552, I respectfully request the following records in possession or control of the United States□ Department of the Interior ("DOI"):□

A 2013 letter or other correspondence from the Scotts Valley Band of Porno Indians ("Scotts Valley") to the Assistant Secretary — Indian Affairs ("AS-IA") requesting  $\Box$ reconsideration of the 2012 Indian Lands Opinion rejecting gaming eligibility of a parcel of land in the City of Richmond, California. To facilitate DOI's search, we note that this record may be dated

July 24, 2013, may be from Don Arnold, Scotts Valley Chairman, and may be addressed to Kevin K. Washburn, AS-IA. Further, this record is referenced in footnote 5 of a September 19, 2013, letter from Assistant Secretary Washburn to Scotts Valley Chairman Arnold and was attached to that

2. A November 2024 communication from Bureau of Indian Affairs Pacific Region Regional Director Amy Dutschke to Director of the Office of Indian Gaming Paula Hart. Under the Freedom of Information Act, I respectfully request access to any records, reports, correspondence, or memoranda, including inter-agency communications, regarding:  $\hfill\Box$ 

• Elistorical or administrative changes to the racial classifications of individuals recorded as "Free Persons of Color," "Indian," "Negro," "Mulatto," or "Colored" in the United States from 1790 to 1960.[

• The criteria, instructions, or federal directives used to alter or revise these classifications, particularly in relation to individuals and families with ancestral ties to tribal communities, especially east of the Mississippi River.  $\Box$ 

• Any documentation referencing the Bureau of Indian Affairs, Dawes Commission, or census authorities that involved the removal or exclusion of persons originally recorded as Indigenous or tribal affiliated from subsequent enrollment, land allotment, or racial designation records.

•Internal memos, studies, or correspondence that addressed or justified the reclassification of individuals with Indigenous family origins as non-Indian racial categories under shifting federal, census, or enrollment policies.  $\Box$ 

This request includes, but is not limited to, policy manuals, internal memoranda, tribal enrollment instructions, census protocols, and federal land designation documents related to racial or tribal

identity during the 18th, 19th, and early 20th centuries.  $\square$ 

If any part of this request is considered overly broad, I welcome guidance on how it may be refined. I request digital copies of the records, and I respectfully request a fee waiver as this is for public interest research and educational purposes.  $\Box$

Furthermore, I am submitting this request because I descend from Indigenous American families traced to the mid-1700s, native to what is now West Virginia, specifically those whose identities were later recorded under non-Indigenous racial categories during federal and state classification efforts. My ancestors were part of the Eastern tribal nations who remained in Appalachia, resisting forced removal and surviving under labels such as "Free Persons of Color" "Black" or "Negro," despite retaining community, language, and kinship systems consistent with their Indigenous roots.

This request supports a personal and public-interest effort to recover documentation related to that identity alteration.  $\hfill\square$
