On behalf of the Yocha Dehe Wintun Nation, a federally recognized tribal government ("Yocha Dehe" or "Tribe"), and pursuant to the Freedom of Information Act ("FOIA"), 5 U.S.C. § 552, I respectfully request the following records:

- Any cultural resources monitoring plan, draft or final, regarding a Scotts Valley Band of Pomo Indians ("Scotts Valley") project in California (including any appendices, exhibits, or attachments thereto).
- Any comments on item 1.
- Any communication to, from, or copying the California State Historic Preservation Officer or her staff regarding items 1 or 2.
- Any communication to, from, or copying Acorn Environmental regarding items 1, 2, or 3.
- Any other communication to, from, or copying Scotts Valley (b) (6) regarding items 1 through 4.

For each of items 1 through 5 we request any documents or other communications dated, generated, received, forwarded, or modified between March 27, 2025, and the date on which you begin searching for records responsive to this request.

The term "communication" in this request includes, but is not limited to, letters, electronic mail messages, text messages, meeting requests, voicemails, and any other communications transmitted in any form.

Although Yocha Dehe would meet the requirements for a waiver of all copy and research fees, to expedite production of responsive documents the Tribe is NOT seeking such a waiver at this time. However, Yocha Dehe respectfully requests that you provide an estimate of any fees or costs expected to exceed \$1,500.00.

Yocha Dehe further requests that responsive records be released as soon as they are available. To the extent that a subset of the requested records is readily available, the Tribe requests to receive those records while you search for other records or complete other administrative processes.

Yocha Dehe is amenable to receiving electronic copies of the requested records. If you intend to make records available electronically, please do so in pdf format.

FOIA requires the release of all reasonably segregable non-exempt portions of responsive documents. 5 U.S.C. § 552(b). Should any documents be withheld, in part or in their entirety, please inform Yocha Dehe of the grounds for denial and the specific administrative appeal rights which are available. 5 U.S.C. § 552(a)(6)(A)(i).
