This letter constitutes a document request, on behalf of (b) (6), under the Freedom of Information Act and an immediate notice to preserve the requested records pursuant to the civil procedure rules of the U.S. Court of Federal Claims and the United States District Courts. We hereby request the following documents under the Freedom of Information Act. In addition, you are hereby put on notice that my clients have claims against the United States Government and the Bureau of Indian Affairs ("BIA") that will likely result in litigation. Therefore, you are obligated immediately to preserve, and instruct all your subordinate employees to preserve, the following: 1. All documents in your custody or control relating to the incident in or around late March 2020 where approximately 30-40 horses belonging to my clients were shot, killed and mutilated in and around (b) (6), and approximately 70-80 other horses belonging to my clients were stolen. - The criteria, instructions, or federal directives used to alter or revise these classifications, particularly in relation to individuals and families with ancestral ties to tribal communities, especially east of the Mississippi River.
- Any documentation referencing the Bureau of Indian Affairs, Dawes Commission, or census authorities that involved the removal or exclusion of persons originally recorded as Indigenous or tribal affiliated from subsequent enrollment, land allotment, or racial designation records.
- Internal memos, studies, or correspondence that addressed or justified the reclassification of individuals with Indigenous family origins as non-Indian racial categories under shifting federal, census, or enrollment policies.

This request includes, but is not limited to, policy manuals, internal memoranda, tribal enrollment instructions, census protocols, and federal land designation documents related to racial or tribal identity during the 18th, 19th, and early 20th centuries.

If any part of this request is considered overly broad, I welcome guidance on how it may be refined. I request digital copies of the records, and I respectfully request a fee waiver as this is for public interest research and educational purposes.

Furthermore, I am submitting this request because I descend from Indigenous American families traced to the mid-1700s, native to what is now West Virginia, specifically those whose identities were later recorded under non-Indigenous racial categories during federal and state classification efforts. My ancestors were part of the Eastern tribal nations who remained in Appalachia, resisting forced removal and surviving under labels such as “Free Persons of Color” “Black” or “Negro,” despite retaining community, language, and kinship systems consistent with their Indigenous roots.

This request supports a personal and public-interest effort to recover documentation related to that identity alteration.

I also request access to any records, correspondence, or internal memoranda related to concerns over the accuracy or legitimacy of tribal enrollment during the Dawes Commission period (circa 1898–1914), including:

- Known or suspected instances of non-Indigenous individuals enrolling onto tribal rolls, whether through misrepresentation, influence, or financial incentives.
