
## **Conservation Worksheet**



## **Recommendations for Property:**

- 1. Control weeds and brush through herbicide applications or mowing. Control weeds with Cimarron Plus or 2,4-D, control brush and sprouts with application of Remedy. Herbicides will be supplied to lessee by the Bureau of Indian Affairs when available.
- 2. Reduce invasive undesirable species of weeds and brush and enhance desirable species through prescribed burning. Prescribed burns are to be conducted by the Bureau of Indian Affairs Personnel and approved by appropriate officials prior to burning.
- 3. Livestock water supply consists of three ponds, two that are shared. Property consists of 109.21 acres of native & woodland pasture.
- 4. Recommended year long stocking rate on Native and Woodland Pastures = 17 cow/calf units.

## **Property Notes:**

- 1. Road access.
- 2. Fencing needs work. The Bureau of Indian Affairs Chickasaw Agency does offer a fencing program when supplies are available.
