

Bureau of Indian Affairs Lifts Response Level Notice at Weber Dam

Schurz, NV - On May 17, 2023, the Bureau of Indian Affairs Superintendent, Western Nevada Agency in Carson City, Nevada issued a Level 1 Response Notice at Weber Dam due to a slowly developing and unusual situation at Weber Dam that could potentially progress into a life-threatening event. Today, August 4, 2023, the Western Nevada Agency is announcing it is lifting the Level 1 Response Notice because the potential for the emergency has passed.

Local recreationalists using Weber Reservoir are advised to stay at least 50 feet from the intake structure (see photo) as dangerous currents and whirlpools are known to exist in this area and are very dangerous to swimmers and individuals in small watercraft (tubes, air flotations, kayaks, canoes, and paddleboards).
